## **ASSIGNMENT**

Over the summer, you are tasked with reading and annotating *The Awakening* by Kate Chopin. **Please include at least 2-4 meaningful annotations per chapter.** You can choose to purchase a new or used copy of this novel by visiting Amazon or Bookshop. You can also find a free digital PDF here. If you choose to use the digital PDF, please make sure you find a way to annotate on your PDF. Many students find it easier to print it off at school or at a local library.

When we return to school in August, you will be asked to use your annotations to create a crime board that depicts which forces are responsible for the events that occur at the end of the novel!

Check out the following annotation/reading strategies to help guide your reading experience:

## **ANNOTATION/READING STRATEGIES:**

While annotating you can...

- 1. Form a **connection** to your personal life, the world around you, or to another text.
- 2. Ask a **question** about the information you are taking in.
- 3. **Summarize** or clarify long, confusing, or important passages that you may want to recall later on.
- 4. Make a **prediction** about what could happen next.
- 5. Make an **inference** about how a character feels about their surroundings, other characters, the conflict, etc.
- 6. **Define** unfamiliar vocabulary. Try to context clues!
- 7. **Evaluate** or form an opinion about something mentioned in the text.

Remember: Your annotations should be written out; otherwise, it's unclear why you marked a specific passage
